- FAFSA-This year you will be able to file the FAFSA beginning OCT 1. Students & parents will use their 2015 tax information for completing the FAFSA, ensuring that income info is readily available.

- Review your transcript for errors
- Attend local college fairs.
- Get recommendations using bio sheet from college office
 Begin filling out applications
- Be aware of **deadlines** if applying Early Decision/Action.

NOVEMBER

- Take SAT. Be sure you used your colleges' codes to send scores. CUNY 2950
- Keep organized-know deadlines.
- Submit completed applications, college/scholarship, with 3 unattached stamps, to college office on your free period.

 Request information about scholarships and financial aid from your target colleges.
- Check/apply for private outside scholarships.
- Remember: College/scholarship applications due to College Office
 2 weeks in advance of any deadline
- Application deadlines need to be met 2 weeks before. Do not depend on the mail or the college office to get them there on time!
- You must let the college office know about every college you apply to

DECEMBER

- SAT/ACT Take exam/send scores.
- Finish all draft applications and essays.
- Submit ALL remaining applications to College Office – DEADLINE – before winter break
- Talk to graduates who are home from college.
- ALL ONLINE APPLICATIONS REQUIRE THAT YOU SUBMIT A TRANSCRIPT REQUEST ENVELOPE TO COLLEGE OFFICE
- APPLY- deadlines?
- Scholarships
- Start thinking about financial aid applications
- Go to college office for information
- Athletes become a member of the NCAA (college office for details)

JANUARY

- Make sure transcripts are up to date when the new term begins. If your college requests them, submit mid-year grade request forms and envelopes – Rm. 114B.
- KEEP COPIES OF ALL FORMS YOU SUBMIT.

- IF you did not apply to a college yet-you must do so as soon as possible.
